



Woman to Woman Grant South Central Conference Mennonite Women

The South Central Conference Mennonite Women's organization is a group whose mission is to encourage growth in discipleship through shared fellowship, worship and service. It also seeks to serve as a financial resource to women in member congregations by making funds available to meet certain needs. Examples of this may include a woman who would like to attend a Mennonite college and could use tuition assistance, scholarships for workshop registrations, a women's group needing financial resources to purchase Bible study materials, or a woman who is facing hardship within her family (outstanding one-time debt, family counseling, etc). Grants range in size from \$50-\$500.

An individual may submit a proposal on behalf of herself, a proposal may be submitted on behalf of another woman, or a proposal may be submitted by a church group on behalf of a group of women.

Qualified applicants are requested to meet the following criteria:

- A member or regular attendee of a South Central Conference church
- Demonstrated financial need with few or no other resources to meet the requested financial need
- Have not applied for a previous grant during the calendar year

Grant request information will be kept confidential. An anonymous exception will be made for reporting purposes, and names will be used only with the grantee's permission.

Once a proposal has been received, it will be reviewed and considered by the executive committee at their next meeting. The executive committee will do its best to respond in a timely manner. Applicants will be notified by phone or email if their application has been approved or declined. Approved proposals will be funded as soon as possible.

If the grant is to be applied to outstanding expenses, a bill must be submitted so that remittance can be paid directly to the organization or business that is owed money.

Follow-up

A copy of the receipt and/or a brief follow-up report should be submitted to indicate how and when the funds were used.
